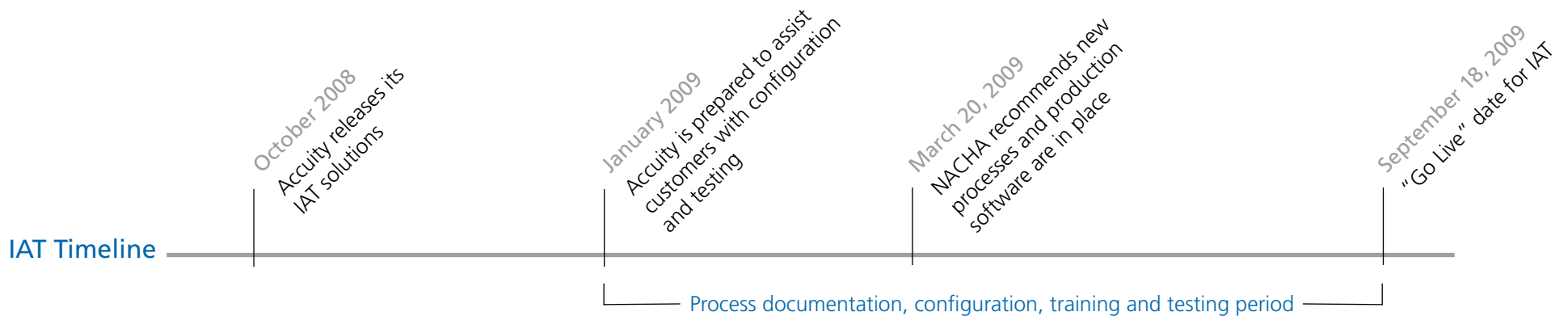


Getting Ready for IAT

NACHA has pushed back the “go live” date for International ACH Transaction (IAT)—from March 20, 2009 to September 18, 2009. However, all financial institutions that deal with payments processed through the U.S. ACH Network need to start preparing for this new rule. Below are several questions to ask yourself to help your organization get ready for IAT:

- Are you working with screening software vendors that are prepared to handle these new message formats?
- Are you set up to receive payments formatted as cross-border? (Even organizations that do not currently send or receive ACH payments need to be prepared to receive the new format)
- Are your systems updated accordingly?
- Has your process been reviewed with your ACH operator?
- Has your process been reviewed with your customers? (If you originate International ACH Transactions)
