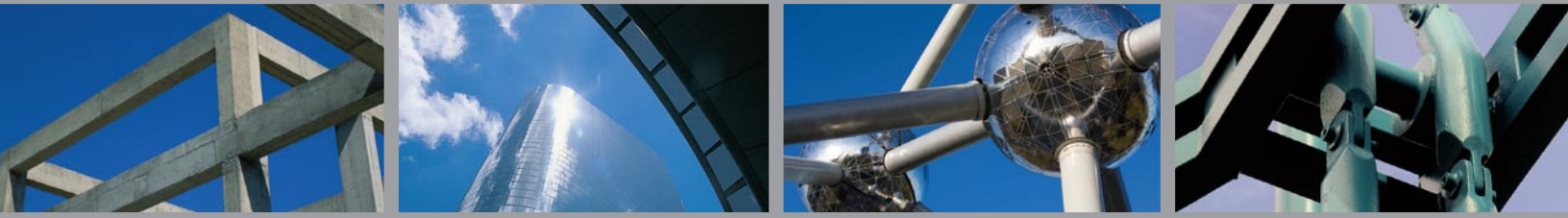


Politically Exposed Persons Due Diligence Database

What is a PEP?

A uniform definition for a “Politically Exposed Person,” or PEP does not currently exist. U.S. legislation, such as the USA PATRIOT Act, describes a PEP as a current or former senior official of government, a major political party, certain corporate leaders, and immediate family members, including spouses, parents, siblings, children. The description also includes any individual publicly known (or known by the relevant financial institution) to be a close personal or professional associate. PEPs are considered “higher risk” individuals and require an enhanced due diligence process.

Why do I need to screen for PEPs?

Heavy fines have been imposed on financial institutions that conduct business, even unwittingly, with customers engaged in illicit activities. While doing business with an entity on a PEP list is not forbidden, it is extremely important to pay attention to entities on the list and their close associates as they potentially pose a risk of financial loss, criminal complicity and/or embarrassment.
