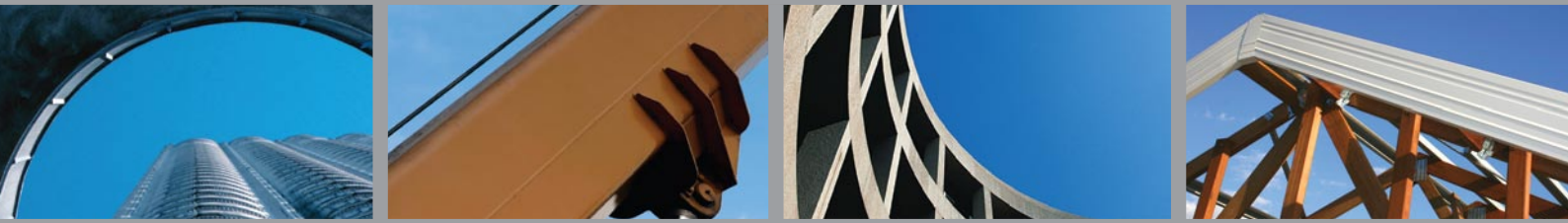

For unconnected SWIFT/BICs IBAN Payment Resource provides the connected SWIFT/BIC enabling you to easily create the SWIFT MT103+ message for efficient payment STP.

This tool instantly validates the structure of an IBAN providing detailed error messages to guide further research. IBANs are also deconstructed, providing information including the institution title, national clearing code, SWIFT/BIC, branch title and full street address. For those who also license The Global Banking Resource™ (TGBR), the SWIFT/BIC result links directly to TGBR offering additional payment information on SEPA Credit Transfer, CHIPS, TARGET, EBA, EURO1 and EURO2 (PE-ACH) to ensure complete and error-free transactions.

IBAN Payment Resource performs check sum validation of legacy account numbers as well by incorporating approved Modulus algorithms to validate the check digits in an account number. This added layer of validation can reduce IBAN rejections caused by transcribing errors.

To streamline your workflow, IBAN Payment Resource also features IBAN Conversion, an add-on module designed to anticipate payment processing obstacles. IBAN Conversion produces properly-formatted IBANs with valid IBAN check digits using a customer-supplied ISO Country Code (or Country Name), bank branch code and account number. It also indicates whether the legacy account number passes check sum validation. This module helps you comply with Single Euro Payments Area (SEPA) mandates requiring an IBAN for payment processing.
